- 2. Approval of Minutes The minutes were presented and voted on without dissent.
- **3. Legislative Update**. Greg Turner presented an update of legislation of interest; SB 398 (Skinner) Local Licensing and SB 59 (Caballero) Provisional licensing.
- **4. Organizational Update**. Greg Turner presented an update on CCA's 3Quarter Budget noting that organizational revenues and costs remain in line with the approved budget and discussed items expected for the Board's approval of the FY 21-22 budget in June. Greg Turner also updated the Board on the organization's Banking Pilot project and Working Groups.
- 5. Requested Discussion CCA Member Value. This discussion was put over to the May 21 meeting.
- **6. Platform Update**. Adam Crabtree provided a brief update on the Platform, specifically the pending roll out of the Transparency Project.
- **7. Public Comment.** There was no public comment.



# The Transparency Project

The Transparency Project is an effort by CCA to provide the public within Member Counties a look into the activities of commercial cannabis within their County. We had initially intended to roll this out in more of a snap-shot report for Members, but the NCS Team has leapfrogged the static report and is prepared to deploy a dynamic version that will be imbedded in CCA's website and linked to respective Member sites as well.

The attached represents the general look and feel of what we plan to roll out. The data included will be updated monthly, automatically.

The data points that will be included initially are listed below and represented on the attached mock-ups. The purpose of our discussion for the Board Meeting will be to identify any objections or concerns to this "Phase 1" before we roll it out.

As the site goes live, we can continue to discuss, evaluate, and update the items we are reporting. As presently planned, the data to be included in the site will be:

#### General data:

- Total licenses
- New licenses granted in the last XX days (30?)
- License types
- Cultivation type break down
- Total reported sales
- Total transfer count

#### Cultivation Data

- Total plants in the ground
- Count of "new plants" in the last month
- Total harvested plants/weight


#### Retail Data

- If the County has less than 3 licenses No data will be displayed to protect confidentiality.
- Between 3-5 licenses
  - Sales mix ie 50% flower, 10% vapes, 30% edibles, etc
- Between 5-10 licenses (in addition to the above)
  - Average price for the major categories ie \$8.00/g flower, \$10/vape cart
- More than 10 licenses (in addition to the above)
  - o Total retail sales
  - Total transaction count




